Ess Lake Owners' Association Annual Meeting

Saturday, July 2, 2016 *Time: 10:00 a.m. – 11:30 a.m.* Where: At the Tennis Courts ***Please bring your chair*** ***Coffee and donuts will be served***

We encourage all members to attend the meeting. The more interaction we have from our community the better our community will be. A proxy is enclosed for those members who cannot attend. We need a quorum to conduct the meeting, therefore, we ask that you return the proxy. You can assign your proxy to an individual who will vote your proxy or you can assign your proxy in general which allows the Association to meet the quorum requirement.

The Board of Directors has met on five occasions to conduct Association business. It was a busy year with many accomplishments being realized due to the cooperation and efforts of many of our community members.

Outlot C: The port-a-potty will be set up again this year near the tennis court & pavilion. We will add new speed limit signs in the area of the access point.

Security Patrol: John Quist continued his security patrol over the winter. He did find one shed door open which he closed. He also had a door open on a vacant house. He investigated to make sure nothing was removed from the house and made sure the door was closed. Place Liens/Remove Liens: No additional liens have been issued. The outstanding liens to date are at \$1958.00. For those members who are in arears, we ask that you would get current with what is owed to the association. Please contact Sharon Quist with any questions about what is owed. Thank You!!

<u>Regular Business:</u> We continued the registration of Ess Lake Owners' Association with the State of Michigan. We continued the liability insurance coverage for the Association, as well.

Canal Project: Mark Pollard has been working with the DEQ to form an acceptable plan to shore up the banks of the mouth of the canal. Mark has submitted a plan to the DEQ for laying stone on the banks, the DEQ has rejected this proposal. The DEQ wants rock that has been dug into the banks of the canal. Mark is in the process of getting the regular permit renewed on-line. He is having trouble due to his email address not being registered on their system. Mark is also in the process of getting permission letters from the property owners to do work on the easement in the canal area. He needs to get these letters signed by the property owners before 5/26/16 to get the permit. This will renew the current dredging permit for another 5 years. Mark will then start working on a new permit for a proposal to put in 30 feet of seawall on each side of the canal.

Building Committee: There have been a number of structures erected without proper plans being submitted for approval by the Building Committee. Letters have been sent to individuals who are not in compliance with our restriction. Please submit plans if you are constructing any structure on your property.

<u>Tree Removal Committee:</u> Two requests to remove trees were granted this past year. If you need to remove trees for safety reasons, forest management or building requirements, permission must be requested and granted prior to removing trees.

Fishing Committee: Lee Kleinow of the fishing committee has talked with the biologist out of Gaylord about the stocking of Ess Lake. He is having discussions with them monthly. The biologist has told Lee that last year 10,000 fingerlings were stocked in Ess Lake. Since they stocked last year, this year they will not stock the lake. The biologist needs reports on what is caught in Ess Lake. We need to take pictures of what is caught next to a ruler. This way they can tell the age of the fish and track it back to the year stocked and the conditions of that year. This information is needed or the stocking program will go away. If you know of anyone fishing in Ess Lake, please spread this information to them and please help Lee with this by e-mailing the above information to him at: kleinowl@gmail.com

Lee also asked about setting up fish shelters. In order to do this, we will need to obtain a permit.

Gravel Pit Area: The wood pile in this area has not been burnt yet as the wood is to wet and it will not light. Mark will try again on 4/15/16 to burn the pile. If this does not work, we may have to bury the stumps in that area so that it gets cleaned up.

<u>Clean Up Weekend:</u> Our **Annual Clean Up Weekend** will be held on 5/21/16. We ask that all members show up at the tennis courts at 10am on this date. There are many items to get accomplished during this weekend. They include:

- Marking all of the Outlots with the correct labels
- Putting the picnic tables out at all of the Outlots
- Cleaning up of all of the debris along the right away of the roadways in the Association(Red Pine, Alpine, Norway, Pinecrest, Ess Lake, Pine Tree and Hill)
- Flower Planting
- Outlot Clean up

The more volunteers we have the quicker the work will go. If we do not have enough interest a service will be hired to do the clean up.

<u>Annual Boat Parade</u>: The annual boat parade will be held on Saturday July 2, 2016 at 9:00pm. All that wish to participate, please meet at the boat launch. Dress up your boats any way that you wish so that all will enjoy!!

Declaration of Restrictions:

Approval of Plans, Article VI: No building, fence, wall or other structure shall be erected, constructed, altered or maintained upon said property unless a complete set of plans and specifications including the exterior color scheme and materials together with a plan indicating the exact location on the building site of the building, water well, septic tank, and tile field, shall have been submitted to and approved in writing by the Association.

Trees, Article IX: Association members must seek written approval from the Board to remove trees (Pine, Oak, Maple or Birch trees) greater than six (6) inches in diameter unless it is within eight (8) feet of an approved structure.
