<u>Website:</u> Our Association Website has been updated with many new features. <u>Canal Project</u>: Mark Pollard continues to pursue this initiative. Due to COVID last year, the project could not push forward due to a lack of stone available. Mark is in the process of upgrading the permit to be able to install 45' of seawall along each side for the canal, then install the riprap. The riprap material is here and John Quist is now looking for the necessary stone to help with the completion of this project. Mark hopes to change the application soon so that work can begin in the spring to complete this much needed project.

Duckweed: Mark Pollard had Aquatic Nuisance Plant Control review the duckweed issue in the canal. This person said that the duckweed can spread to the lake, so it does need to be treated soon. This would be a problem in the lake where there are little to no wave action. This is spread into the lake by boats and kayaks going through the canal. Please see enclosed letter pertaining to this issue.

<u>Norway Court Dead Trees & Canal Clean up</u>: Presque Isle Electric did cut down many trees along Norway Court, but the cleanup still needs to be finished up. John Quist has been cleaning up some of the area that he can safely get at. This project remains on the board's goals to complete.

Security Patrol: The security patrol will continue this year with John Quist. If there are any issues, John will be in contact with you.

Tennis Court: The tennis court revitalization has been completed. It has been upgraded with the new pickle ball court as well. The board can't thank Aimee Smith enough for leading this project. We also would like to thank the Wilkerson's for the use of their water in assisting with the repairs. Aimee will soon purchase a sign and look for

benches to add some finishing touches to the court. Mark has a pole to repair the fence opening. He has also had a gate installed that could be equipped for the use of a combination lock to secure the area so that it would only be available to association members. The practice board for tennis will be removed sometime in the spring due to it rotting.

Pickle ball: Are you interested in playing pickle ball? Do you know what it is? It's a fun sport that combines many elements of tennis, badminton and ping pong. Building & Tree Removal Committee: All construction of buildings and major changes to lots must be reviewed by the building committee. **A plan must be submitted to Mark Pollard for approval and record retention.** Tree removal according to the Bylaws and restrictions is permitted with permission depending on the size of the tree, however the board is requesting that you contact the committee prior to removal of any trees, in case there are concerns from the board or other association members.

<u>Variance Request & Building Plan Approvals</u>: The board has recently put in place forms to be able to request a variance to the restrictions, as well as a form for the approval of building plans. This is in an effort to reduce the number of violations that exist in the association for items that have not been approve, thus violating the current restrictions. Reminder of Oak Tree Removal & Oak Wilt: The following is from the DNR about Oak Wilt: "The normal timetested advice is to prevent oak wilt by not pruning or otherwise 'injuring' oaks from **April 15 to July 15**. The spread of oak wilt occurs during this time of year as beetles move spores from fungal fruiting structures on the trees killed last year by oak wilt to wounds on healthy oaks." Please do not trim or plan to cut down any oaks during this time period. This will help prevent the spread of this disease in our area. We have heard that there may be Oak Wilt near our area now. If you "Google" Oak Wilt, you can gain more knowledge about the spread of this disease.

<u>Reminder for Unleashed Dogs</u>: We continue to encourage residents to walk their dogs with a leash. To help protect the association, signs are installed on all outlots stating: "Dogs Must be on Leashes". Your current Board of Directors supports all State, County and Township leash laws. Please abide by these laws while you have your dogs out & about.
